

# 2024 Player Schedule & Guidelines Hawks Prairie Pickleball Club (HPPC)

**Membership, Waiver, and Dues:** Open to adults over 18 years of age who are residents of Jubilee or Edgewater upon submission of completed membership application, waiver, and \$15 annual dues payable by check before your first play in the calendar year. Membership runs January 1 to December 31. Non-members are not allowed during club-play time. **2024 Club Play Schedule:** *Club time is 8 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. for April through October and 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. for November through March.* 

By agreement with the Hawks Prairie Community Association, during club time we have exclusive access to courts 1, 2, and 3, Monday through Friday. Court 3 is not available for pickleball outside of club time. When court 3 is in use the club is responsible for deploying the divider net and closing it at the end of play. The key and instructions are in the storage room.

Check the schedule at the club website for skill levels allocated to each time slot. This allocation may change based on observed court use and will be reflected on the club website. You may play with whichever group you choose, but no more than two hours during club time. Skill level definitions may be found on the USAPA site's *Definitions of Player Skill Ratings*.

# Court Etiquette:

- Please be respectful of all players' choice of play category.
- Please be kind; show good sportsmanship in action and speech.
- Only a receiving team may determine in/out calls; observers, please keep silent.
- Face away from the court when chatting off-court to avoid distracting players. This is especially important during event/tournament play.
- When a ball is accidentally hit into another court, immediately call "ball in court." Play should immediately stop until the ball is returned to the proper court to the recipient with raised-hand.
- Please limit your noise level out of respect for Edgewater residents.

**Edgewater Parking:** Please park only along the park edges of <u>Logan Drive NE</u> or <u>McKinley Drive NE</u>, not on both sides of those streets. Walk or bike to the courts when possible, to avoid parking congestion.

# **SAFETY:**

**Court Shoes:** You <u>must</u> wear proper shoes on the courts. Please wear only shoes with non-marking soles to avoid leaving marks on the court. Shoes designed for tennis are recommended because the sole is designed for hard courts and the shoe provides support for quick lateral movement on outdoor courts.

**First aid kit and AED:** Located in the Pickleball Storage room. You are responsible to return it to storage if you are the last one to leave. Training on use of the AED is recommended. Contact club vice president.

#### Access to Club Owned Equipment:

- **Storage room key**: Available from the club treasurer upon signing responsibility agreement and paying fee.
- Gator shed key: Club officers have access to this key.
- o Basketball court divider net storage key and instructions in Pickle Pen.

- HPCA manages all non-club-time reservations using the HPCA website. Residents can request a password by emailing websitehpca@gmail.com and then go to www.hawksprairiecommunityassociation.com, then Pickleball, Pavilion, Parks & Trails, then Reserve Pavilion/Pickleball Courts, then Pickleball Courts to access the Reservation Calendar.
- Modify or cancel an existing reservation promptly when you must.
